

# MID-AM REPORT

**O**f the 169 drivers registered in the 2007 Mid-Am Championship, just one has run all five races to date.

That would be **Mark Zwolle** (MidS), twice a winner at Memphis and Gateway to take a stout early lead in arguably the toughest class in club racing today, Spec Miata. In his other three races, Zwolle has two seconds and a third for 49 points.

Just one point less is the total for **Andy Wolverton** (Neb), leading ITE again with four victories. The only other driver at 40 or more is **Jeff Seelig** (StL) who's won twice in ITA.

Only two other drivers have even reached 30 points to date. **Curt Weilandich** (StL) tops ITC with three victories and 36 points. **Ed Mabry** (Ark) stands second in ITA with a win at Hallett and 30 points.

Every Region has drivers registered in the Mid-Am Championship this year. It's no surprise the list is led by Kansas City Region with 44. St. Louis Region shows 29 so far. Ranked third is Nebraska Region at 17.

Also in double digits are Des Moines Valley with 13 Mid-Am drivers, Mid-South with an even dozen, and Wichita showing 10 on the list.

Three Regions have eight drivers each -- NeOkla, Oklahoma and Ozark Mountain. Southern Illinois lists six, Kansas has five, Arkansas has four, Salina shows three and Mississippi has two.
